SHIRT of the DAY

SANCTION SCALE

If you need to sanction someone for misbehavior, you must use the following scale:

- Warning: no sanction
 - Step 1 – verbal
 - Step 2 – yellow card (must be noted on the scoresheet)
 - Only one yellow card is permitted per team per match.
- Penalty: sanction
 - Red Card – loss of rally, point and service to the opponent
 - Red and yellow together – expulsion for the set
 - Red and yellow apart – disqualification for the match

TARAFLEX

The playable surface for the taraflex courts is only up to the front of the benches. Players may not play the ball in between the chairs and the referee stand or the chairs and the table.
