## **SHIRT of the DAY**

## **REMINDERS**

1. The coach must be the R2 on all matches. Make sure the coach has a hand held whistle. If they do not know where theirs is, send them to the championship desk.
2. Point YOUR electronic whistle towards the court, not towards the ceiling.
3. After each match, check your What's App for any updated, current messages. (If you are not getting messages, stop by the office for assistance.)
4. No more than 2 coaches should be standing at one time.
5. The pressure of the game ball will be checked prior to the start of the day by the desk referee.

The bleach in the table spray bottles should be diluted more tomorrow. But be careful of getting the spray on your clothing. Use the towels, if necessary. Return all used towels to championship.

## **DECIDING SET PROCEDURES**

If teams need to play a deciding set, the R1 will conduct another coin toss with the two captains. The winner of that coin toss will have their choice of serving or receiving for the deciding set. The teams will stay on the same sides during the deciding set as they played on in the two previous sets. Teams will not switch sides halfway through.

There should be bags to carry the game balls in tomorrow. Get at least one towel, preferably 2 towels to leave on the court at all times. Bring all the court equipment back at the end of the wave.

There should be water at each championship desk for the referees.
