Remember our professionalism. It's not cool to be over friendly with coaches. We talked about once we've done the coin toss, we shouldn't be talking.

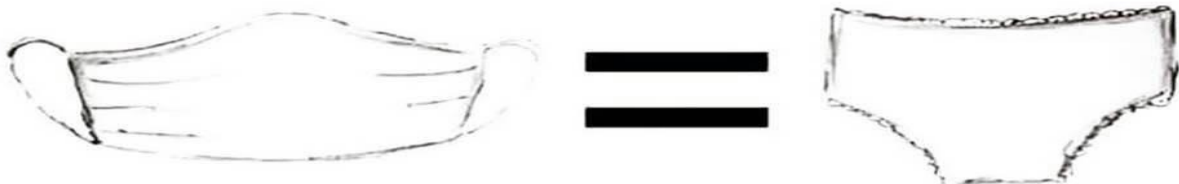
Thank you for adapting everyday to the changes. Especially last night and this morning when I changed the deciding game procedures 3 times. I am so sorry for all those changes.
