Covid-19 Fall Sports Spectator Guidelines

General Guidelines for Spectators at all Fall Events

- Face coverings are required at all indoor events, and expected when social distancing measures cannot be met outdoors.
- Spectators should use six feet social distancing. Families may sit or stand together but should social distance from others.
- Game announcers will give frequent reminders of the COVID-19 guidelines during events.
- All spectators are responsible for screening their own health before attending events. If you feel sick, please stay home.
- Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face.
- Failure to follow guidelines may result in removal from the event.

Football Spectator Guidelines

- During all school district football games, face coverings are required for all spectators entering the complex; exiting the complex; and when moving around.
- Each coach and participant (football, cheer, dance and band) will submit the names of four family members to be placed on a pass list at the beginning of the season. If a player or coach wishes to change the names of the individuals on the pass list, he/she must contact the Athletic Office prior to the day of the event. Only individuals listed on the pass list will be admitted to the event.
- City, MRC or school passes will not be issued this school year.
- Admission for spectators on the pass list are as follows:
 - \$2 for all Middle School games
 - \$6 for all adults at 9th/Reserve/JV/Varsity games
 - \$4 for all students at 9th/Reserve/JV/Varsity games
 - Exact change is highly recommended and spectators will follow social distancing when waiting in line.
- Visiting Teams will be allowed 2 fans per player/coach on the roster at varsity football games (exception being the AL vs TJ varsity game)
- There will not be student sections at football games this season.

Volleyball Spectator Guidelines

- Face coverings are required for all spectators.
- The first two rows will not be available for spectator seating. Areas will be marked off in each gym where seating is not allowed.
- Each coach and player will submit the names of four family members to be placed on a pass list at the beginning of the season. If a player or coach wishes to change the names of the individuals on the pass list, he/she must contact the Athletic Office prior to the day of the event. Only individuals listed on the pass list will be admitted to the event.
 - In gyms with seating on only one side of the gym, 2 family members will be allowed.
- Admission for spectators on the pass list are as follows:
 - \$2 for all Middle School games
 - \$5 for all students and adults at 9th/JV/Varsity games
 - Exact change is highly recommended and spectators will follow social distancing when waiting in line.
- City, MRC or school passes will not be issued this year.
- There will not be student sections at volleyball games during the 2020 season.

- Visiting Teams will be allowed 2 fans per player/coach

Girls Swimming Spectator Guidelines: Kirn MS Pool

- Face coverings are required for all spectators.
- Each coach and player will be allowed three family members (four if one volunteers to be a timer) to be admitted to each home dual swim meet. Only these individuals will be admitted to the event.
- Admission for spectators will be \$5

Cross Country Spectator Guidelines: IWCC Campus

- Face Coverings are expected when social distancing cannot take place.
- There will not be a limit on attendance at home cross country meets due to the venue being outside.
- We ask that social distancing between immediate families takes place.
- Gathering in large groups at the start and finish of races is not allowed.

Fall Boys Golf Spectators Guidelines: Dodge Riverside Golf Course

- Face Coverings are expected when social distancing cannot take place.
- There will not be a limit on attendance at home golf meets due to the venue being outside.
- We ask that social distancing between immediate families take place
- Gathering in large groups at the start and finish of meet or in the golf clubhouse is not allowed.

Concessions

- When ordering from the concession stand, please maintain social distance.
- When possible, we ask for you to use exact change at the concession stand.
- There will not be seating near the concession stand. Spectators will take food/drink back to the gym area.

Media Guidelines

- All media will maintain social distancing of 6 feet during interviews. Members of the media should contact the school prior to attending the event.
- School and District media representatives who are photographing or videotaping the events will maintain social distancing of 6 feet at all times.

Noncompliance with these guidelines may lead to spectator removal from fall events.
