

## **AAU Classic Tournament Information – Saturday March 6 and Sunday March 7**

### **Parking Passes**

You can pick up a parking pass tonight between 7:00 pm and 8:00 pm at the Rosen Plaza Hotel (9700 International Drive). Park in the left side of the drop off area (or find a parking spot) and go into the lobby area (stop and get a temperature check). Proceed to a grouping of gray chairs (to the left of the check-in desk) where Debbie Knuth (863-528-2388) will be handing out parking passes. It's okay if you do not know Debbie, look in the area I just described and I'm sure you will figure it out. You can call her ONLY if you cannot find her. Do not call her and ask her to wait for you.

If you cannot make it between 7 and 8 pm, you can proceed to Carlos Rodriguez (512-762-4258) hotel (Springhill Suites, 8840 Universal Dr) between 10:00 pm and 10:30 pm.

### **WEST CONCOURSE PARKING – VERY IMPORTANT**

To park at the convention center – West Concourse, follow the signs for West concourse or use the parking map that was previously sent (and is posted on my website at omnevb.net) When you park, park as close to the main entrance on the west side (towards Hall A) as possible. You must enter the main entrance (large glassed-in entrance, also the entrance to the Boat Show), cross over the dock area, then turn right and proceed to Hall A.

The officials room is W202b which is between the Exit door (A3) and the Spectator Entrance (Door A2). The player entrance is Door A1. All officials will enter using the spectator entrance (A2). You will pass through a temperature check area and you will drop your tournament waiver off at the entrance. If you did not bring your tournament waiver, stop in the officials room to pick up a copy.

You must also have a copy of the QR code that is attached to this message. You can take a picture of the QR code and present it on your phone if you want. Otherwise carry a paper copy of the code with you. Paper copies can be picked up in the officials room.

### **Pre-Tournament Meeting**

There will be a pre-tournament meeting for all referees at 7:00 AM (tomorrow Saturday morning) in the officials room (W202b). Make sure you allow enough time to park and walk, walk, walk to get to the officials room (an estimated 10-15 minute walk).

There will be concession stands available for food outside of the playing area. No food or drink (except water) can be consumed in the playing area. If possible, bring lunch with you as we are short referees.

If you have numerous matches in a row, but need a break, take 5 minutes or so to go the officials room to grab a bite to eat or drink. Let Carlos know that you are taking a short break.

At the morning meeting be prepared to complete an AAU pay voucher.

### **Admittance Protocol for Officials/Staff:**

We are looking forward to having you participate this year at the AAU Volleyball Classic!

We appreciate your dedication to this event the AAU amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

### **Health and Safety Protocols**

In working with the Orange County Convention Center and local and state officials, we have several protocols that will be in place throughout the event including the following:

- All officials and staff will need to go through a health and temperature check each day. If you are experiencing a fever or any Covid-19 symptoms, you should not attend the event. Doing so could greatly impact your ability to participate in future events.
- All officials and staff must wear a face mask at all times.
- All officials and staff must enter through the Spectator Entrance only. This is located in front of West Hall A 2. The only exit to the building will be through West Hall A 3.

- Officials and staff are encouraged to bring their own water. Water stations will not be provided this year.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the facility. Please be sure to follow CDC guidelines when setting up your booth/lines.
- Officials and staff should allow for social distancing at all times.
