

Notes for Saturday, March 13

A rostered adult must be the second referee - NO players! NO exceptions!

- During the coin toss, you must have the players stand on each of the attack lines, while you stand at the centerline. You must maintain social distance while at the scoring table. Do not hover over the players (even if you are all wearing masks).
- If you are unable to enter the scores from your match, make sure to tell the desk that the scores have not been entered when you return the score sheet—do not just put the completed score sheet in the box.
- Do not use cell phones on the stand!
- The first match of each wave MUST START on time.
- When in doubt, accept a protest, even if you think it is not protestable. Let us come and handle it.
- Pay attention to the benches and locations of players—players should be standing near the end of the bench and off the playing area.
- The Libero jersey MUST be contrasting. One jersey should be dark in color, the other one should be light in color. Dark blue/black, navy/dark gray, purple/dark gray are NOT contrasting. The coaches also know they are not contrasting but will wear them if you allow them to.
- Before you get on the stand to begin your match, CHECK the score sheet and confirm everything is filled out correctly. Make sure the teams are recorded on the correct sides for both Set 1 and Set 2; make sure Serve/Receive has been recorded for both sets, including the X for the receiving team for both sets; check to see that the scorer has entered the lineups correctly.
- If you are concerned about the competency of your scorer, it is acceptable to get off the stand between sets and check-in with your scorer to be sure everything is correct. Do not linger at the table—quickly confirm the score sheet is accurate and return to the stand.
- When you finish the matches on your court, if your replacement referee has not arrived, please inform the championship desk that the referee is not at the court. Be aware of the other officials in your group. Check the grid posted on the website for names.
- At the end of the wave, you must bring the game ball back to Championship. Do not leave the ball at the court. Check the posted online grid to see if you are the last one on the court. (1:00 pm is the last scheduled match in the am; 8:00 pm is the last match in pm).
- Only 3 (no more than 3) workers at the scoring table.
