

2022 AAU Points of Emphasis

You need to pay **SPECIAL ATTENTION** to these items in the referee guidelines.

1. Phone number to contact office staff/desk referees: Office Staff – 531-772-3340

 2. All requests (assigning requests, clothing exchanges, etc.) **MUST** be made through an online request form. The **online request form** is available at www.omnevb.net.
 3. Officials' assignments will be posted at <http://www.omnevb.net/aau-schedules.html>
 4. Credentials must be used to enter to playing area AT ALL TIMES. Do not try to get in without the proper credential.
 5. All coaches on the bench must be wearing a **PURPLE** wristband.
 6. A coach (wearing a **PURPLE** wristband) or a chaperone (wearing a **NEON YELLOW** wristband) must be the **2nd referee** if their team is scheduled to work and a paid R2 is not provided.
 7. Every match of the tournament will be live streamed by Baller TV. Read the powerpoint for details about how this system will work.
 8. **Rosters must be checked before EVERY match! A coach from each team must initial below their roster after they have verified that it is correct. The referee must still double-check the roster, and the R1 will initial once in the roster area. Review the powerpoint for complete information about rosters.**
 9. Teams may not use personal music devices courtside.

 11. The "sport court rule" interpretation has changed slightly. Review the current rule interpretation on the slide 35. Speak with a lead referee if you have any questions.
 12. Review slides 37-39 for reminders about uniform rules. If a team has questionable uniforms or a non-contrasting Libero jersey, ask the coach if they have any other options. If you believe the uniforms are illegal or non-contrasting, contact your lead referee for assistance.
 13. The first match of any wave **MAY NOT START EARLY** (8:00/8:30 AM and 3:00/3:30 PM matches). Subsequent matches may start up to 15 minutes early, all teams involved agree.
 14. Review slides 53-55 for information about handling protests.
 15. **The AAU Libero rule is different than the USAV rule. The team may identify two DIFFERENT Liberors for every set regardless of the designation in previous sets.**
 16. Review slides 71-81 for reminders about professionalism!
 17. The check-out procedure has changed this year. Review slide 20 for more information.
