

# CROSSROADS ADDITIONAL UPDATED REFEREE INFORMATION

## TIME CHANGE

The time will change on Saturday night – spring forward. If you are not sure if your phone will change, call the front desk (or your friends) for a wake-up call.

## COIN TOSS

Teams will not switch sides, so the only acceptable procedure for the coin toss is allowing the winner of the coin toss to choose serve or receive or choice of court. (It is not acceptable to allow a 'higher seeded' team to choose their court.)

## LIBERO

AAU allows a team to choose two (2) new liberos for each set.

## TEAM UNIFORMS

We must continue to be diligent about uniforms. 'I can tell the difference' is NOT an acceptable answer. Remember the new rule about the uniform number must contrast to the jersey color and cannot be formed by just an outline. Most uniforms are checked on day 1, but don't forget to keep checking on days 2 and 3 too.

## SCORESHEETS

It is so loud in the facility. It is difficult for us to hear which scoresheet you need. Can you please use the following codes to request your sheet:

- A - Alpha
- B - Bravo
- C - Charlie
- D - Delta

At the start of each match, before the scorer writes on the sheet, make sure she has the correct scoresheet and the correct teams are getting ready to play.

It's okay if you get off the stand between sets 1 and 2 to check on your scorer. Make sure they know what they are doing and then get back on the stand. That could save you some heartache later when you find that she's been writing 'X's' instead of exit scores.

Between waves, you can leave the pens and pencils on the court. Just make sure you bring back (or have secured) the game ball.

The second flipper (on the R1) side MUST sit in the first chair.

## COURTESY

Please be courteous to your fellow referees and do not interrupt or interfere with their current match. If you are waiting for the next match, keep your belongings with you.

## LAST MATCH on the COURT

If you are the referee for the last match on the court, place the R1 flipchart on the R1ref stand. Bring back pens, pencils, towel and game ball.

## FINALS DAY INFO

- Remind teams at the coin toss that the losing team must stay to officiate. We do not have extra bodies, so if you allow the work team to leave, you are responsible for finding your own work team.

- Scoresheets later in the day depend on the winner of your current match. If your next match is on the same court, enter the previous scores, do a coin toss, start the first 4 minutes then come back to the desk for the new scoresheet.

- Starting at 11 am on the final day, you can go up to the referee office and verify your match counts. An accurate verification of all match counts will ensure that your payment is processed quickly.

## LAST MATCH on FINAL DAY

In addition to bringing back all the other required items, please help us:

- Bring back GRAY flipchart (from R1 side). Leave BLACK flipchart on R2 stand.
- Take court number off net and bring back to championship.
