We have two more days to go and these will be the most important days. The play will get more intense and faster. Please go home and get as much sleep as possible, so you are ready to finish out this session.

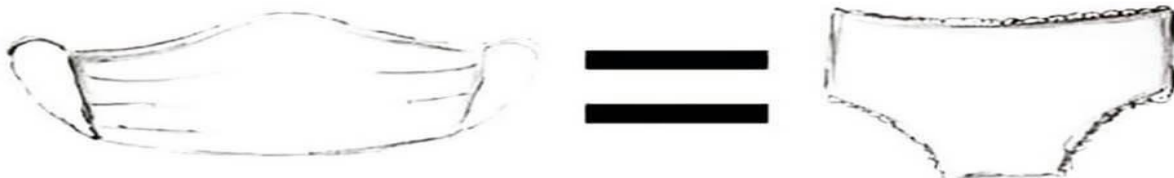
EQUIPMENT
