Paperwork:

- Check in will be at the mezzanine F office in the Convention Center on the night before the event between 2-6 pm. (Go to main entrance at top of escalator. Keep going north along the outside wall to the "Q" elevator. We will have signs to help guide you) and 6:30-7:30 the morning of the event. Please contact us if you are coming in the morning of the event.
- W-9 needs to be completed (attached if you want to print & bring or send back electronically)
- Direct Deposit bank form (attached if you want to print & bring or send back electronically)
- Give cell number and USAV ranking
- Checks will be issued electronically after the event.

Referee

- Referee room is #103 downstairs in the convention center. Don't leave valuables in the room.
- Concession Food is available at the site.

Uniforms

- Navy Blue Pants (AAU jackets and shirts can be worn)
- Shirts: Saturday: Blue or white
 - Sunday: Gray or white (or purple Jacqueline shirt if you already own one)
 - Monday: White (or AAU Shirt)
- Patches will not be worn. No jewelry that will attract attention.

Court Scheduling will posted on tm2sign and omnevb.net.

- Report to your court no later than 7:30 am for the 1st wave or 2:30 pm for the 2nd wave.
- National Anthem at 7:45 am and 2:45 pm followed by the coin toss.
- Referee Schedule available on tm2sign.com
- Scores will be entered on your phone through tm2sign. Review scoresheets before turning them in.

Match Management

- USAV rules apply with no "regional" protocols to be used.
 - AAU allows the changing of 2 liberos per each SET.
 - 12 and under are NOT allowed a 'step-in' for serving.
- First referee of the wave will be responsible to take out the court supplies and last referee of the wave returns them. (NOT the flip scores)
- Missing Team (playing or work) – let tournament desk know just before the coin toss.
- Please handle Uniforms (team or libero) issues. Please ask the coaches to "check" their bags to find uniforms that are in compliance. If not, the coach may come to championship to seek exemption. Let's all try and help each other out and address issues and be consistent.
- Warm up 2-4-4 (Teams get an opportunity of 5 min. for the 1st match of the day)
 - Serving must be done within their own 4 minutes.
 - No shared hitting
- Officiating crew
 - Coach or registered and rostered adult as the R2 (No Players)
 - Scorekeeper
 - Libero tracker who can also be score flipper
 - 2 line judges
- Coaches - 2 allowed to stand, but only head coach can address the officials.
- Keep matches going, if there is a problem send someone to get the head referee.
